

Milk supply to processing enterprises, by sector












Commodity structure of dairy product import

Association of Milk Producers (AMP) is a non-profit, voluntary organization, officially registered on April 30, 2009. As of 2021, AMP unites about 150 farms with a joint land bank of over 1.3 million hectares, which together keep 86 thsd cows or 20% of the total industrial cow population in Ukraine, produce almost 25% of all industrial milk and 50% of "extra" grade milk. AMP strives to protect the rights and interests of dairy farms, achieve world production standards, and popularize milk consumption by using modern technologies and supporting educational and other industry events, including National Dairy Farm Days and International Dairy Congress.

Dairy Center Kishenzi (DCK) is an innovative platform for training and upgrading the qualifications of farm specialists: farm managers, veterinarians, zoo technicians, artificial insemination operators, milkers, and hoof trimmers.

DCK strives to promote the development of the most powerful dairy industry in the world with practical training to build up a skilled workforce. In 2021, 28 events were held on the basis of DCK, 18 of them online. In total, more than 1,000 people graduated.
